#### Position Summary:

This position is responsible for conducting activities that further develop the Pit River Tribe's Ecological Restoration Program. Responsibilities include:

- Maintaining and developing Native Plant Propagation at the Tribal Nursery and shade-house arbor.
- Research, development, and update of Best Management Practices for propagation of California Native Plants and restoration practices.
- Development of site specific planting plans for Tribal Projects.
- Coordination and planning for seed and plant materials collections.
- Propagation, schedule development, maintenance, and implementation.
- Conduct outreach and educational activities.

#### Qualifications/Experience:

This position requires background and experience in Botany, or other related discipline such as Watershed Science, and Restoration Ecology. Preferred experience includes college level course work in; Botany, Mycology, Plant Physiology, Plant Anatomy, Plant Taxonomy, Lichens & Bryophytes, Ecology, Ethnobotany; Genetics, Organic Chemistry, Physics, Calculus, Statistics, Biology and Zoology.

The position requires experience and understanding of restoration ecology, and ability to coordinate schedules, collaborate with volunteers and staff. Ability to be comfortable to work outdoors and traverse mountainous and rugged terrain. Knowledge of organic/natural nutrients and fungi and bacteria to use as bio-control pesticides and nonchemical techniques to care for Northern California native plants, and native plant propagation techniques for use in

large scale restoration projects. Knowledge of organic/natural nutrients and fungi and bacteria to use as bio-control pesticides to care for Northern California native plants for multiple agencies restoration projects.

**Other Duties Include:**

- Coordination with Environmental Director on research, policy planning and capacity building activities that support environmental and natural resources protection in line with the Tribe's Environmental Planning and protection goals.
- Maintaining communication with the Pit River Tribal Council, Cultural Committee and Tribal Environmental Programs Office.
- Maintain Greenhouse and plants and purchase supplies as needed.
- Construct and maintain irrigation.
- Other tasks as assigned.

**Indian Preference**

Preference given to qualified Native Americans under the Federal Indian Preference Act (43CPR17.3 [d]). Applicants claiming Indian Preference must submit verification of Indian certification by tribe of affiliation or other acceptable documentation of Indian heritage.

**Note:** *This position requires an awareness and deep appreciation of the Pit River Tribal Indian tradition, customs, and socioeconomic need. It requires the ability, at all times, to meet and deal effectively in contacts with Indian people and organizations. This requires tact, courtesy, confidentiality, discretion, resourcefulness, and good judgment in handling sensitive issues.*
