

Natural Resources Crew – full time seasonal

The Pit River Tribe Natural Resources department will be working on several grants. The first is the one below. This is a five- week project and once done the youth would have the opportunity to work on the next project.

***“Spring Canyon Tribal Forest Ecosystem and Wildlife Habitat Restoration Project on the XL Reservation.”***

This project will train, equip, and empower **5 youth, ages 18-25** with **training, certification and work experience** that treats 20 acres of the 253 acres of sage steppe juniper landscape. This work will also reduce wildfire risk in the wildland urban interface, (WUI), of the **XL Reservation** and protect current housing for tribal residents. Hazardous fuels removal will include small diameter juniper. Work will also include riparian restoration in Spring Canyon. The tribal youth will develop the skillsets, certifications and training to be able to work in a natural resource career path. The Pit River Tribe, Natural Resource Director, Emergency Operations Director and TERO Officer of the Pit River Tribe will work collaboratively to manage, oversee, and report on the outcomes of this grant in a timely manner.
